A ham radio station using the DSES club call sign, KØPRT (Plishner Radio Telescope) will be on HF and VHF radio bands. Using the big dish we will also be working Earth-Moon-Earth (EME) contacts on 1296 MHz – **hear your own voice bounced off the moon!**



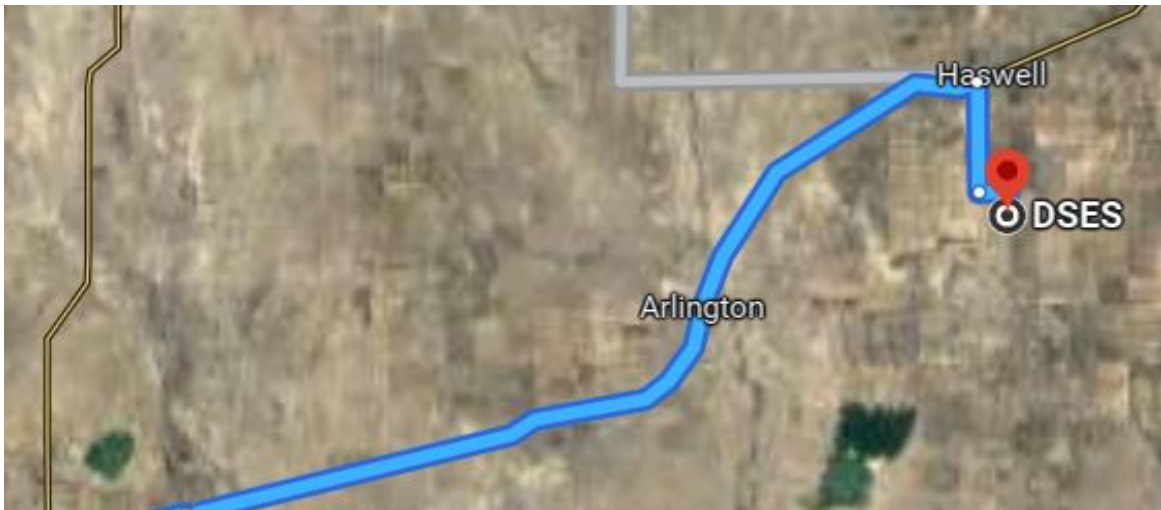
